








Dominican Republic's tourism in numbers (2019)



Puerto Plata

When Christopher Columbus arrived at the island of Hispaniola on his first voyage in 1492, thanks to the color of the sun's glare on the crystalline ocean waters, he named the region - Puerto Plata. It is also known as the Bride of the Atlantic and as the Amber Coast, for its incredible and unique collection of amber, with inclusions of insects and different shades.

It is located on the outskirts of Loma Isabel de Torres, where its warm waters and variable winds have made it known worldwide as the preferred capital for the practice of water sports and sailing. Here, you will also find the Ocean World Adventure Park, the San Felipe Fortress, the factory of the famous Brugal Rum, the 27 Damajagua Falls, the small and charming Cayo Arena (or Paraíso) Island, and much more.

Its crystal blue waters and fine golden sand capture the attention of its visitors, where the wind keeps water sports enthusiasts captivated, and others relax under the sun. All this together with the vibrant nightlife of this province is what keeps them always wanting to come back.

Ocean World Marina















With the passage of time and the development of this exceptional tourist pole, there has been a steady increase in the number of tourist accommodation rooms in this area, with greater emphasis in 2018, with a year-on-year increase of 5.1%.

In 2019, Puerto Plata tourist area will account around 10% of the country's hotel rooms. More than 4 hotel chains have operations in the area, equivalent to 26 hotels.



Silver Bank



Humpback whale watching season in Samaná Bay attracts visitors from around the world from mid-January through March, when the giant mammals come to mate and give birth in Dominican waters. You can actually swim and snorkel with these majestic creatures, but only in the Silver Bank Sanctuary—or Santuario de Mamíferos Marinos Banco de la Plata, located north of Puerto Plata's coast—and only from three boats approved by the Dominican government.



FORTALEZA SAN FELIPE

Built in the years from 1541 to 1577 by the Spaniards in order to protect Puerto Plata from pirates and other intruders. It is the most solid historical remnant of the colonial architecture of that era.

LOMA ISABEL DE TORRES Y TELEFÉRICO

Breathtaking views of the city of Puerto Plata can be appreciated from the Loma Isabel de Torres. A thrilling 10-minute cable car ride takes visitors to a height of 810 meters through dense clouds to the highest mountain. Upon arrival, you will encounter Christ the Redeemer, a replica of the statue found in the city of Rio de Janeiro and will delight in walking among the colorful and and exuberant varieties of exotic flowers that abound within its botanical garden.



MUSEO JUDÍO

Black and white photographs tell the story of Europeans fleeing Nazi Europe who settled in Sosúa as cattle ranchers and farmers. Here, the Jews developed a new community that eventually flourished.

PLAYA DORADA GOLF COURSE

It was designed by legendary golf course architect Robert Trent Jones Sr. in 1976. It is located within the Playa Dorada complex, sharing the area with a dozen hotels. Playa Dorada Golf Course stands out for the excellent quality and conditioning of its green areas.





LOS MANGOS GOLF COURSE

Redesigned by P.B. Dye in 2010, Los Mangos has 18 holes, 9 of which have ocean views. Located 10 minutes from the city of Puerto Plata and among lush mango, lemon and coconut trees, this course is within the Costambar complex. Regardless of the level of knowledge, here golfers achieve their goals through professional lessons with the latest and best equipment for the game.

PLAYA GRANDE & OCEAN CLUB

Open since 1997, it was the last course designed by Robert Trent Jones Sr. and is considered one of the best in the country. Located in the nearby María Trinidad Sánchez province, between Cabrera and Rio San Juan, this golf course is for the exclusive use of the hotel's guests and its members. Ten of its holes are played along the cliffs of the Atlantic Ocean, which is why it is referred to as the "Pebble Beach" of the Caribbean. The course is fed by abundant subway waterfalls of fresh water. Its lush terrain boasts numerous ancient trees and royal palms, and is bordered by extraordinary forests and colorful small farms. www.playagrande.com

NIGHTLIFE

Puerto Plata's nightlife offers fun salsa clubs and vibrant bars, where Dominicans and visitors dance to the sound of the most contagious merengue. In addition, most resorts feature nightly shows that boldly fuse different artistic expressions such as dancing, music, singing, costumed characters, merengue lessons, beauty contests and karaoke.



SHOPPING

There is always time for shopping and here you will find amber, larimar, cigars and exquisite Dominican rum. Within the Playa Dorada complex you will find a small shopping mall with gift stores and restaurants.

MARINAS

Marina Luperon is located in the bay of the small town of Luperon. It is an inlet with natural protection and has anchorage and mooring facilities for various types of yachts. www.luperon-marina.com

GRI-GRI LAGOONS

It is a beautiful and peaceful lagoon - a sanctuary for colorful birds - located among dense mangroves near the town of Rio San Juan, 100 km east of Puerto Plata. There you can take a boat ride and explore its mangroves and the Cueva de las Golondrinas (Cave of the Swallows).

BRUGAL RUM FACTORY

The Dominican Republic is famous for its rum and it is in Puerto Plata where this drink is made by Dominican hands. It is distilled and aged from sugar cane, ensuring an authentic Dominican flavor and making it a favorite of many.

This excursion will take you from Playa Dorada to Playa Sosúa, on a trip where colorful fish and playful dolphins will swim alongside you in the warm waters of the Atlantic.

ZIPLINES IN YASIKA ADVENTURE PARK

As soon as you arrive, it's all thrills and chills. In this park, the adrenaline is at its peak as soon as you start flying, attached to a cable, over lush green valleys.







CARIBBEAN LASER MIDWINTER REGATTA

It marks the start of the world Laser Sailboat racing calendar and attracts the best sailors in the world. Held every January in Cabarete, the world capital of wind sports, this event is sponsored by the Laser Training Center with the help of the Dominican Sailing Federation.

CARNAVAL DE PUERTO PLATA

Carnivals are held every Sunday during the month of February on the Malecon of Puerto Plata. This tradition has been going on since the 19th century. Both visitors and Dominicans enjoy the parades, music and popular dances, costumes and demonstrations of art and culture.

Upon arrival, you will feel like you are on the secret island of your dreams, surrounded by soft white sand and turquoise waters, ideal for snorkeling.

DOMINICAN RUM FESTIVAL

Attendees to this festival will be able to enjoy in July a great exhibition and tastings of fine Rums from the Dominican Republic and international brands. CONCERTS AT LA PUNTILLA AMPHITHEATER

La Puntilla is an impressive 2,062 square meter Greek amphitheater facing the Atlantic Ocean with seating for 4,000 spectators. Flanked by the San Felipe Fortress and the green La Puntilla Park, throughout the year it is the perfect setting for concerts, dance performances and other artistic events with the participation of Dominican and international artists.

Tourism Development Council

On October 9, 2001, the National Congress approved Law No. 158-01 on the promotion of tourism development for the poles of scarce development and new poles in provinces and localities of great potential, with the purpose of accelerating a rationalized process of development of the tourism industry in all the regions with potential and natural conditions for their tourism exploitation throughout the Dominican territory.

In the referred law, the Tourism Development Council (CONFOTUR) was created, with the purpose of implementing the guidelines of Law No. 158-01, as well as creating the necessary conditions and facilities so that innovative tourism projects may benefit from the incentives granted by the law.

Decree No. 372-14 created the Technical Directorate of CONFOTUR, in charge of handling all technical matters derived from the application of Law No. 158-01 and its amendments. The files requesting Classification, in order to benefit from the terms of Law 158-01 and its amendments, must be sent through the CONFOTUR web page by completing the Application Form. The Technical Direction will carry out the technical and legal evaluation of the projects and will be in charge of recommending to the Council the exemptions for each application it evaluates.

A Classification, whether Provisional or Definitive, is nothing more than the approval by the Council for the Promotion of Tourism (CONFOTUR) of a given tourism project as eligible for the benefits and incentives of the Law.
